ITI Tech Voting Guide for the 112th Congress

(2011 - 2012)

The ITI Tech Vote Guide serves as both a report card for members of Congress on key policy issues facing the technology sector, and as a reflection of ITI's legislative priorities for the 112th Congress (2011 – 2012).

House Vote Ratings for the 112th Congress

H.R. 1249, Leahy-Smith America Invents Act: Legislation to amend U.S. patent law to define the “effective filing date” of an invention as the filing date of the patent or the patent application for the given invention, thereby, moving from a “first to invent” to a “first inventor to file” system.

ITI's Position: **Yea**

With significant patent portfolios tied to many goods and services around the world, many ITI member companies must utilize and interface with the Patent and Trademark Office (PTO). With a constant backlog of pending patent and trademark applications, the PTO is in need of a modern, effective system that serves applicants and provides for thorough and efficient processing. The bill improved the patent system and patent quality by stabilizing funding for the PTO by allowing it to set its own fees and keep those fees for its operations and not for other government agencies; moving to the “first inventor to file” system; allowing third parties to submit prior art for consideration; and ending frivolous “false marking” litigation. H.R. 1249 represents a significant step forward in reforming the patent system.

H.R. 3078, United States-Colombia Trade Promotion Authority Implementation Act: Legislation implementing the United States-Colombia Trade Promotion Agreement.

ITI's Position: **Yea**

International trade is an engine for America's economic strength and job creation. ITI is committed to creating new opportunities and expanding global trade for U.S. technology products and services. H.R. 3078 provided Congressional approval for the United States-Colombia Free Trade Agreement (FTA).

H.R. 3079, United States-Panama Trade Promotion Authority Implementation Act: Legislation implementing the United States-Panama Trade Promotion Agreement.

ITI's Position: **Yea**

More than 50 million American workers are employed by firms engaged in international trade – a figure that grows every year. To ensure domestic economic and job growth, ITI supports policies that open global markets for U.S. technology products and services, promote free and open competition, rely on market-based solutions, and protect intellectual property. H.R. 3079 provided Congressional approval for the United States-Panama FTA.

House Vote Ratings for the 112th Congress

H.R. 3080, United States-Korea Free Trade Agreement Implementation Act: Legislation implementing the United States-Korea Free Trade Agreement.

ITI's Position: Yea

Our sector competes in a fiercely competitive, fast-growing global market. Therefore, ITI is committed to pursuing ambitious initiatives to reduce trade barriers and increase market access for American technology products and services, ensuring our members' ability to create jobs in the United States. H.R. 3080 provided Congressional approval for the United States' trade agreement with the Republic of Korea.

10/12/2011: Roll Call Vote #783, 278-151

H.R. 2832, Trade Adjustment Assistance Extension Act of 2011: Legislation repealing the termination date for trade adjustment assistance (TAA) programs under the Trade and Globalization Adjustment Assistance Act of 2009, and amending the Trade Act of 1974 to extend duty-free treatment under the Generalized System of Preferences (GSP) through 2013.

ITI's Position: Yea

TAA assists American businesses in exporting, while also providing displaced workers with new skills and resources to re-enter the 21st century job market. ITI members support TAA programs as part of a broader trade agenda. H.R. 2832 extended TAA and GSP through December 31, 2013, and July 31, 2013, respectively.

H.R. 3630, Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012: Legislation authorizing voluntary incentive auctions to ensure that scarce and valuable spectrum can be relocated to maintain U.S. leadership in mobile broadband.

ITI's Position: Yea

Increased broadband fosters investment, job creation, and innovation in the United States. H.R. 3630 allocated additional spectrum for mobile broadband.

House Vote Ratings for the 112th Congress

H.R. 3523, Cyber Intelligence Sharing and Protection Act (CISPA): Legislation to improve the ability of the private sector to voluntarily share cyber threat information with others in the private sector and the federal government.

ITI's Position: Yea

ITI believes increased voluntary cyber threat information sharing between the private sector and the government and within the private sector is critical to protecting individuals, U.S. businesses, and the federal government. H.R. 3523 included provisions allowing for a cyber threat information sharing system that helps protect and defend networks and provide limited liability protection to those companies who voluntarily participate in the system.

04/26/2012: Roll Call Vote #192, 248-168

H.Con.Res. 127, Expressing the Sense of Congress Regarding Actions to Preserve and Advance the Multistakeholder Governance Model under which the Internet has Thrived: Non-binding resolution stating U.S. officials should continue to promote a global free Internet and advance a successful multistakeholder governance structure ahead of the 2012 World Conference on International Telecommunications.

ITI's Position: Yea

ITI strongly supports the multistakeholder approach to Internet governance. H.Con.Res. 127 expressed Congress' endorsement for the preservation of the multistakeholder model currently governing the Internet.

08/02/2012: Roll Call Vote #555, 414-0

H.R. 6156, Russia and Moldova Jackson-Vanik Repeal and Sergei Magnitsky Rule of Law Accountability Act of 2012: Legislation amending the Trade Act of 1974 to grant permanent normal trade relations (PNTR) for the Russian Federation and Moldova.

ITI's Position: Yea

ITI actively works to expand market access for technology products around the world. H.R. 6156 authorized the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment to Russia and Moldova, and cleared the way for Russian membership in the World Trade Organization (WTO).

House Vote Ratings for the 112th Congress

H.R. 6429, STEM Job Act of 2012: Legislation amending the Immigration and Nationality Act in order make 55,000 visas available in FY2014 for immigrations who: 1) possess a doctorate degree in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM) for a U.S. higher education institution; and 2) have taken all their STEM doctoral courses while residing in the United States.

ITI's Position: Yea

The technology sectors understands the significant value of foreign-born STEM students to U.S. innovation and economic growth. Foreign-born professional helped to create a quarter of all high-tech startups from 1995 to 2005 and are responsible for a quarter of global patents filed in the United States. H.R. 6429 allowed foreign-born U.S. graduates with a master's degree or higher in STEM fields to work permanently in the United States rather than overseas for our foreign competitors.

H.R. 1249, Leahy-Smith America Invents Act: Legislation to amend U.S. patent law to define the “effective filing date” of an invention as the filing date of the patent or the patent application for the given invention, thereby, moving from a “first to invent” to a “first inventor to file” system.

ITI's Position: Yea

With significant patent portfolios tied to many goods and services around the world, many ITI member companies must utilize and interface with the Patent and Trademark Office (PTO). With a constant backlog of pending patent and trademark applications, the PTO is in need of a modern, effective system that serves applicants and provides for thorough and efficient processing. The bill improved the patent system and patent quality by stabilizing funding for the PTO by allowing it to set its own fees and keep those fees for its operations and not for other government agencies; moving to the “first inventor to file” system; allowing third parties to submit prior art for consideration; and ending frivolous “false marking” litigation. H.R. 1249 represents a significant step forward in reforming the patent system.
